

The twelfth Taranaki Multi Ethnic Extravaganza is on Saturday 18th March at Yarrow Stadium, New Plymouth.

The day starts with a colourful parade at 10.30 am down Devon St to the Clock Tower.

Flags of over sixty nations will be carried and among those taking part will be Taranaki dignitaries, floats, marching bands, and ethnic groups in national dress; all in all about 500 people involved.

Once the parade is over the entertainment will begin at the stadium. There you can sample foods at 40 different ethnic stalls, visit art and craft stalls, childrens entertainment areas, and enjoy all - day ethnic entertainment on the 9x6 metre stage.
